

2021-22 EITC Scholarships The Community Foundation Serving the Heart of Western Pennsylvania is providing scholarships through EITC funds to qualified families in Pre-K-Grade 8. Income criteria allows an annual household income of up to \$92,160, and an additional income allowance of \$16,222 for the student and for each other dependent (as defined by the IRS) living within the same household. The deadline to apply is July 15, 2021. Applications are available at https://servingtheheart.org/pre-k-12-tuition-assistance/ or in the school office.

<u>Leah Montag Memorial Merit Scholarship</u> This merit scholarship is available to qualified current St. Luke School students in grades 5, 6, or 7 and is applicable toward 2021-2022 tuition.
